GRANT GUIDELINES

Give Chippewa County favors grant proposals that:

- Originate in Chippewa County and demonstrate strong volunteer involvement
- Promote collaboration and reduce service duplication
- Help people help themselves
- Build upon the strengths of the communities
- Make a tangible difference in meeting an important community need
- Demonstrate a high level of sustainability

Generally, grants will not be funded for routine operating expenses, annual campaigns and/or endowments, re-granting by another organization, direct support of individuals, lobbying or political organizations and ongoing/repeat grants to the same project. Grants are typically awarded between \$750 - \$2,500.
